This form shall be submitted with the title application for the following:

- Any vehicle or recreational product sold, transferred, or conveyed by a new or used motor vehicle dealer on or after September 1, 2016, or
- Any vehicle or recreational product sold between August 12, 2016 and August 31, 2016 that meets the criteria for a water branded title, salvage title or salvage/water branded title.

Failure to include either this form or a Dealer Affidavit of Vehicle Condition with title application will result in the file being rejected.
